The **Cardiolipin Antibody** assays may serve to assist in the diagnosis of antiphospholipid syndrome. The diagnosis can have important implications for the treatment and prediction of recurrent thrombosis and recurrent miscarriage.

**Beta-2 Glycoprotein 1 Antibody** tests can be utilized along with cardiolipin antibody to help diagnose the cause of recurrent miscarriages, an unexplained blood clot (thrombotic episode) or to help diagnose antiphospholipid syndrome (APS), or to detect the autoantibodies in a patient with another autoimmune disorder.
